ZESCO SCHEDULES MAINTENANCE WORKS ON MAIN WESTERN PROVINCE POWER TRANSMISSION LINE

Lusaka, Tuesday, 03 October 2023. ZESCO Limited is to undertake major annual maintenance works on the 66kV Sesheke - Senanga transmission line, the main and sole power transportation route to the Western Province of Zambia. The three-day work will be undertaken on the 7th, 11th, and 15th of October 2023.

During the maintenance period, power supply will be interrupted to most parts of Western Province, which include Sioma, Senanga, Mongu, Limulunga, Kalabo, Luampa, Kaoma, TBZ, Nalolo, Sikongo, and Mangango from 06:00 hours to 18:00hours on each day.

As a safety precaution, our customers and the public are urged to treat all supply lines to be live at all times, as power supply could be restored before the stated time.

ZESCO is presently at the peak of its annual maintenance season and has intensified maintenance works on its transmission and distribution network countrywide to improve the reliability and safety of power supply to its customers. On 16 and 17 September 2023, ZESCO successfully undertook similar maintenance works on the main power system central corridor's substation situated in Kabwe which feeds five provinces namely Central, Northern, Luapula, Muchinga and Eastern.
