## FOREWORD

We are back again with another special edition of the internal news bulletin covering recent activity highlights.

ZESCO Limited has announced that the construction of the second 330kV Kabwe Stepdown- Pensulo transmission line has reached an advanced stage. The Corporation has also scheduled major annual maintenance works on the main power system central corridor's substation situated in Kabwe to take place on the 16th and 17th of September 2023 from 06:00 hours to 16:00 hours on each day.

Meanwhile the power utility company's quest to provide stable and reliable electricity to its customers countrywide hit another key milestone following the successful installation of two transformers to Itezhi-tezhi which are expected to stabilize and ramp up power supply to the district and the surrounding areas.

The implementation of the ZESCO Limited 10year strategic plan is in full swing with stakeholders keen to assist the Corporate Leadership Team realize positive results. The National Energy Sector and Allied Workers Union (NESAU) are urging unionized workers to play a significant role in ensuring that the five pillars are successfully met.

ZESCO Limited's unrelenting efforts to curb vandalism continue to yield positive results. This month, the Corporations Security Department secured two major convictions of one vandal from Isoka and three from Kabwe for eleven-and one-year imprisonment respectively.

ZESCO Limited has rolled out the last phase of electricity connection subsidy which will pave way for 8,300 new electricity connections. The latest electricity connection subsidies have been broken down as 7,800 for households and 500 small scale enterprises, countrywide. The subsided connections form part of the Electricity Service Access Project (ESAP), an initiative of the Government of the Republic of Zambia and whose primary purpose is to increase access to electricity specifically by the rural populace.

The sponsorship of traditional ceremonies is within the realm of ZESCO Limited's corporate social investment portfolio considering their immense value in preserving Zambia's rich cultural heritage, harnessing, and sustaining national unity, promoting tourism and stimulating small scale commercial activity for local communities. This month ZESCO was at the centre of providing both technical and financial support towards the successful hosting of Ukusefya Pa Ngwena traditional ceremony of the Bemba speaking people.

Zambia's capital, Lusaka was yet again at the heart of hosting the country's annual Sports Expo and Forum organized by the Zambia Diaspora Organization under the theme: "Showcasing Sport's Contribution to National Development." ZESCO Limited, the sole sponsor of ZESCO United for the last 50 years partnered with the Zambia Diaspora Organization in making the inaugural launch a success.

### ZESCO TO EMBARK ON MAJOR ANNUAL MAINTENANCE WORKS ON 330KV KABWE STEPDOWN - PENSULO TRANSMISSION LINE

ZESCO Limited has scheduled major annual maintenance works on the main power system central corridor's substation situated in Kabwe. The works on the main 330kV transmission line from Kabwe Step Down Substation to Pensulo Substation is scheduled to take place on the 16th and 17th of September 2023 from 06:00 hours to 16:00 hours on each day.

The planned maintenance works on the transmission line will necessitate interruption of power supply to most parts of Northern, Muchinga, Luapula, Eastern, Northern and Central Provinces.

#### ZESCO Limited Director Transmission, Operations and Trade Justin Loongo said:

"The 330kV Kabwe Step Down – Pensulo transmission line is presently the sole power transporting conduit from Zambia's major power generating stations in the southern part of the country to the five mentioned provinces in the north. As a long-term solution, ZESCO Limited is constructing the second 330kV Kabwe Step Down-Pensulo transmission line whose works have reached an advanced stage and is scheduled for commissioning by the end of December 2023."

Mr Loongo further added that: "The additional transmission line once commissioned, shall not only enhance the capacity and security of power supply to the fore mentioned provinces but also provide flexibility to maintenance scheduling, such that there will be no power interruption due to line maintenance. As a safety precaution, all customers are urged to treat all supply lines to be live, as power supply could be restored before the stated time."



ZESCO Limited has stabilized and expanded power supply to Ithezi-tezhi districts and the surrounding areas following the installation of two transformers.

Itezhi-tezhi has since November 7,2022 been dependent on low voltage power supply transmitted through Muzuma substation located in Choma as an alternative source following a fault on the transformer which was providing power to the district.

The two transformers which were commissioned on Thursday 31 August by ZESCO Limited are expected to ramp up, stabilize and expand power supply in the district and the surrounding areas.



#### NESAU PRESIDENT URGES ZESCO LIMITED UNIONIZED WORKERS TO SUPPORT CORPORATE LEADERSHIP TO ACHIEVE STRATEGIC PLAN

National Energy Sector and Allied Workers Union (NESAU) president Geoffrey Mbewe says the success of ZESCO Limited's 10-year strategic plan depends on concerted efforts from the corporation's unionized workers.

In February 2023, ZESCO launched its 10-year strategic plan for the period 2022 to 2031. The plan is founded on five strategic focus areas being to achieve customer satisfaction, win customer confidence and loyalty; To be a financially sustainable organization that balances the needs of its stakeholders; to expand the generation, transmission and distribution systems guided by an Integrated Resource Plan; To have an effective maintenance regime for generation, transmission, and distribution systems; and To align human capital to business objectives.

The plan was approved by the Cabinet on 12 July 2023.

Mr Mbewe believes the Union has an important role to play in ensuring that ZESCO Limited Corporate Leadership Team (CLT) achieves success from each pilar of the strategic plan.

"CLT has come up with a 10-year strategic plan which will drive the success of the company and we are a strategic link between them and the unionized employees. It is now our responsibility to drive employees to achieve excellency and be more effective. Remember the more effective employees are the better for the company to realize success and make profits in turn for our staff to benefit through bonuses and other emoluments," he said.

And Mr. Mbewe has urged unionized workers to work extra hard and participate fully in realizing each pillar of the strategic plan.

"As a union, our goal is to encourage our employees to work extra hard and participate in all pillars of the strategic plan that CLT has brought forward to us. I think it is important because CLT can't succeed in attaining the five pillars without the involvement of every unionized employee of the corporation," he said.

ZESCO Managing Director, Eng. Victor Benjamin Mapani believes the successful implementation of the Corporation's 10-year strategic plan is dependent on how well each employee embraced a positive attitude towards work.

Eng. Mapani said this when he addressed ZESCO Limited employees based at the Head Office on 13 July 2023.



#### THREE KABWE VANDALS GET 1 YEAR IMPRISONMENT FOR BEING IN POSSESSION OF ZESCO CABLES

The Kabwe Subordinate Court recently sentenced three vandals to 1 year imprisonment with hard labour after being found in possession of ZESCO Limited cables believed to have been stolen or unlawfully obtained.

Kennedy Phiri aged 33 of Momboshi area and Kevin Nonde aged 21 of Katondo appeared before the Kabwe Subordinate Court on August 17,2023 before being sentenced to 1 year imprisonment with hard labour effect from May 24, 2023, and May 29,2023 respectively.

Meanwhile Brain Phiri aged 21 of Momboshi area who appeared before the Kabwe Subordinate Court on August 17,2023 for committing the same offence has been sentenced to 1 year imprisonment with hard labour effect from May 26,2023 respectively.

And the Chinsali High Court has sentenced Silomba Alinjavwa to 11 years imprisonment with hard labour after being found guilty of vandalising ZESCO Limited-service cables.

Details of the matter are that in 2022, Alinjavwa aged 38 of Sunset compound of Isoka district of Muchinga Province, was arrested for vandalising ZESCO Limited-service cables.

Alinjavwa who appeared for plea on August 31,2023, before Judge Honourable M.L. Zulu was sentenced to 11 years imprisonment with hard labour after pleading guilty to one count of "vandalism of public or private property necessary or incidental to the provision of necessary service to the public contrary to section 341 D(1)(2)(a) of amendment act no.17 of 2007 of the penal code chapter 87 of the Laws of Zambia."

ZESCO Limited wishes to advise the public to desist from acts of vandalism that are detrimental to the Corporation's quest to deliver safe and quality electricity services, efficiently and effectively.

#### ZESCO REINTRODUCES ELECTRICITY CONNECTION SUBSIDY TARGETING 8,300 LOW INCOME HOUSEHOLDS AND SMES

ZESCO Limited has reintroduced the electricity connection subsidy which will pave way for 8,300 new electricity connections broken down as 7,800 for households and 500 small scale enterprises, countrywide.

The subsided connections form part of the Electricity Service Access Project (ESAP), an initiative of the Government of the Republic of Zambia and whose primary purpose is to increase access to electricity specifically by the rural populace. The Rural Electrification Authority and ZESCO Limited are the main project execution agencies.

At its inception in 2017, part of the ESAP component was Component A, that had two main components namely; Component A1 - subsidy Connections and Component A2 - Grid Extension and Strengthening, which received USD26.5 million funding from the World Bank and had an initial connection target of 22,000 low income households and 1000 medium scale enterprises in Five (5) years. As at close of the subsidy project (component A1) on 15 June 2022, a total of 58,411 electricity connections were made countrywide.

The Government and ZESCO Limited have reintroduced the new connection subsidy targeting a total 8,300 connections composed of low-income households and small and medium sized enterprises, countrywide. The subsidy will be accessible on first come, first serve basis and will cease once the targeted number is met. The electricity connections per province are as indicated in the table below;
